### **3) COMPETITION RULES:**

This competition is for teams of three from the armed forces and armies of NATO and allied countries. The competition is in three parts – shooting with pistol, sub-machine gun (assault rifle) type 58 and sub-machine gun type 61.

The competition is intended for reserve units and invited guests. Each shooter has his own target; a further member of his team fulfils the function of spotter for him during the initial firing. The entire team shoots from one firing station and with one weapon in the time given for the individual disciplines multiplied by three. The capacity of this event is 120 contestants; each unit (foreign country) may enter a maximum of two teams.

Members of contesting teams are obligated to participate in fulfilment of organizational tasks in order to secure contest according to instructions of functionaries.

Order of shooting teams will be drawn by lots during presentation. Functionaries – members of shooting teams will shoot in the end of the contest.

Contestants who are not members of the Army of the Czech Republic should arrange their insurance individually, medical service is ensured by the organiser.

### **4) ORGANISATIONAL INSTRUCTIONS:**

All the instructions for competitors, the route of the journey, contact telephone numbers, location of the firing range and accommodation will be accessible on the Internet ([www.army.cz](http://www.army.cz)).

Apparel: Field Uniform

Accommodation: Ensured for the contestants in the Jince – Valdek Military Training Area with own sleeping bag and sheet.

Catering: Ensured against reimbursement in the value of standard daily ration plus bonus for unused ratio for 19.9. 2008 – Supper  
20.9. 2008 – Breakfast, Lunch, Supper.

The transport of participants: to the presentation area in the Jince – Valdek Military Training Area by own means of transport. Parking is ensured in the Valdek area. On 18.9.2008 transport is arranged by the organiser. The use of private vehicles in the Jince Military Training Area is prohibited.

## **5) EVALUATION OF INDIVIDUAL DISCIPLINES:**

### **Individuals – order in individual disciplines:**

Pistol – evaluation of individuals – for 1<sup>st</sup> place evaluated with cup, medal and diploma, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place evaluated with medal and diploma, 4<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> place evaluated with diploma.

Sub-machine gun (assault rifle) type 58 – evaluation of individuals – for 1<sup>st</sup> place evaluated with cup, medal and diploma, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place evaluated with medal and diploma, 4<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> place evaluated with diploma.

Sub-machine gun type 61 – evaluation of individuals – for 1<sup>st</sup> place evaluated with cup, medal and diploma, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place evaluated with medal and diploma, 4<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> place evaluated with diploma.

### **Teams – overall order:**

1<sup>st</sup> team – Cup of the Head of General Staff of the Czech Army – cup for placing for each member of team, diploma  
2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> teams – cup for placing of team, diploma for each member of team  
4<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> teams – diploma

## **6) SAFETY REGULATIONS:**

All marksmen will fulfil the instructions of the section heads in a disciplined manner; increased emphasis is placed on the safe handling of weapons and observance of safety regulations. Arms are handled exclusively on the instructions of the section head, the mouth of the barrel of the weapon aims only into the designated firing sector; nobody may turn their weapon round. In the case of a fault occurring during firing the marksmen will raise his hand to call the section head, which will eliminate the fault. The marksman will not manipulate the weapon himself. Throughout the contest it is strictly prohibited to consume alcoholic beverages or other addictive substances.

**In the case of infringement of these rules the contestant will immediately be disqualified!**

## **7) FINAL PROVISIONS:**

All necessary changes in the organisation and course of the contest are stipulated by the organiser.
